

**AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION  
BETWEEN KOREA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF LAW  
AND THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN LAW SCHOOL**

The Korea University College of Law and the University of Wisconsin Law School conclude this Agreement for the purpose of promoting friendly relations and academic exchange between the two institutions.

AGREED:

1. Each institution will make an effort to promote and develop cooperation in the following activities based upon the principles of equality and reciprocity:

- (a) Exchange of faculty members and research staff.
- (b) The joint development of special short programs and courses.
- (c) Exchange of students.
- (d) Exchange of academic materials and academic publications.

2. In order to carry out these activities a detailed plan may be formed after consultation between the two institutions, with such details to be covered in an Appendix to this Agreement. The Appendix of this Agreement shall be construed to be an integral part of this Agreement.

3. This Agreement shall begin on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2007 and shall continue thereafter for three (3) years, subject from time to time to revisions or modifications by mutual agreement. After the initial (3) years, this Agreement shall be renewed with the same terms, unless either institution withdraws from the Agreement with six (6) months prior written notice.

4. Either institution may terminate this Agreement effective at the end of any calendar year period by giving written notice to the other institutions no less than six (6) months prior to the end of any such year period.
